The purpose of the NNCIL CHAP Program is to enable people with disabilities in Northern Nevada to live in the community as independently as possible.

There are four basic qualifications to become eligible for the CHAP Program:

- A Nevada Resident
- Must have a severe physical disability and limitation in their ability to function independently.
- There must be a reasonable expectation that the services will improve the applicant's functional independence.
- The applicant must have exhausted all other resources (Medicare, health insurance and personal resources).

Services provided by the CHAP Program include:

- Minor Home Modifications (Some services are provided in collaboration with Care Chest of Sierra Nevada.)

- Equipment Loan Program

Early intervention is available to families with children with developmental delays between the ages of birth and three years. Transition services are provided to families when their children turn three in order to ensure they receive continuous intervention in community or school district settings.

Families and Early Intervention staff work as a team to develop a plan with outcomes and strategies appropriate for the unique needs of a child. The team may recommend services from the following list to support and assist families in meeting their child's individualized plan.

- Service coordination; parent training, counseling and home visits; screening, evaluation, and assessment; family needs assessment; assistive technology & devices; audiology services; medical diagnostic/evaluation services; nutrition services; occupational therapy; speech-language therapy; physical therapy; social work services; special instruction; transition services; vision services.
- The Early Intervention programs are provided at no cost to the family. Families are asked to provide billing information for their insurance but never billed for unpaid balances.

We provide homeownership opportunities to low income families and individuals with a variety of financing programs tailored to each applicant's needs. Loans can be provided

with no down payment required at favorable rates and terms. The interest portion of the loan may be subsidized in part by USDA. USDA also offers participation loans with other mortgage lenders and can offer loan guarantees on loans made by other mortgage lenders.

The 504 housing repair program can assist very low income households to modernize or repair a modest home. Grants to applicants 62 years or older are available to rehabilitate a home or provide handicap accessibility.
